

- Yoga mat bag for studio trips




getting around

Most downtown parking is pay. Here's the ParkMobile app download and MPA map.



RIDE SHARE & TAXIS


<u>Uber</u> and <u>Lyft</u> are both available in

THE PRT AT WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY

The Personal Rapid Transit (PRT) is unique to Morgantown. It's five stations connect the three Morgantown campuses of West Virginia

University (WVU) and the city's downtown area. Our closest station is Beechurst.



places to see

WVU CAMPUS

West Virginia University is picturesque place with greenery and waterfront in the vicinity. The building structures are of different architectural styles and its a pleasure to walk around the locality. Free.

THE ART MUSEUM AT WVU

the Art Museum has more than 4,000 paintings, prints, works on paper, sculpture, and ceramics with messages from across the globe and over the centuries. Free.

DORSEY'S KNOB PARK

A short but steep hike to the top of Dorsey's Knob affords beautiful views of Morgantown and it's surrounding scenery. The 70 acre park, located adjacent to U.S. 119, is right outside of Morgantown. Free.

DENTS RUN COVERED

BRIDGE

Built in 1889, this 13 ft wide, 40 ft long bridge covers Dent's Run.
Beautifully preserved and peaceful. Nearby parking lot for convenience. Free.
